CITY OF ST. CLAIRSVILLE PARKS AND RECREATION FACILITIES

J.B. MARTIN RECREATION-SENIOR CENTER AT BELMONT COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS:

A multi-purpose building, including gymnasium and meeting room.

JOHN BUKMIR FIELDS ON NORTH MARKET STREET EXTENTION:

Two little league fields; girls' softball field.

ST. CLAIRSVILLE CITY RESERVOIR:

Fish stock Management Program with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources Division of Wildlife. Fishing requires a State of Ohio Fishing License.

SOUTH PARK:

Lighted basketball court and playground equipment.

ST. CLAIRSVILLE JR. SPORTS FIELDS ON NORTH MARKET STREET EXTENSION:

This area (41 acre site) includes 5 baseball/softball fields and 1 multi-purpose field. Funded by Federal Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant of \$75,398.00. Developed by the City of St. Clairsville Water, Electric, Street, and Recreation Departments, U.S. Army Reserves, Belmont County Human Services, and St. Clairsville Jr. Sports. The Recreation Department received notice from State Representative Charlie Wilson that the application for Ohio Nature Works funds in the amount of \$50,000.00 has been approved through the Ohio Capital Bill. The project was funded and completed in the Spring of 2004. Work included improvements and illumination of the Mustang field as well as fencing for the Flag football/Soccer field. The dedication for this project was held on May 10th at 7:30pm.

NATIONAL ROAD BIKEWAY:

Phase I of the bikeway extends 4.0 miles. The project features 532' long tunnel-40' high, 2 level Plaza Overlook-Cave-like Interior; 60' high X 340' long elevated and curved bridge; Hub Park-28' diameter gazebo in a traffic circle; Nature Walk; Educational materials-labeled plants, walking tour brochure into the National Historic District; Connector to many St. Clairsville destinations/trip generators; Small Kiosks/Stops along the way; Landscaping and natural setting.

REGISTRATION POLICY

Registration can only be done by mail. If you decide to pay by check, please make it payable to: City of St. Clairsville Department of Parks and Recreation. A registration form or rental contract is required for each class, league or rental. No refunds will be given on rentals. No refunds will be issued on a league, special event, camp rental, or any other program.

The Parks and Recreation Department has a non-resident fee for all participants who do not reside in the St. Clairsville-Richland School District. The non-resident fee is \$5.00 per class or youth activity. Therefore, individuals, clubs, groups, or businesses are encouraged to contact the Recreation Department if they have any interest in donating time, dollars, equipment, or materials in an attempt to provide the residents of the St. Clairsville area with quality recreational facilities and programming. The St. Clairsville Department of Parks and Recreation has a late fee policy. Any late registrations are charged a \$5.00 late fee.

Various federal and state funding sources have been utilized to expand and develop facilities and programs. We would like to express thanks to the Ohio Department of Development and the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for their help. Since 1981, the city has received grants totaling over \$1,707,000.00 and in kind services of over \$3,291,000.00 in federal and monies, as well as numerous donations from local community businesses, clubs, organizations, and residents. Without these vital donations, our services would not be possible.

The J.B. Martin Recreation-Senior Center is available to rent for wedding receptions at a cost of \$450.00. The facility is air conditioned with a legal seating capacity of 450 people. The Recreation Department provides set up, tear down, and clean up. The choice of caterers is entirely up to the renter. Alcoholic beverages are permitted. However, there is no sale of alcoholic beverages permitted in the facility. The Parks and Recreation Department has staff at the facility during the 3 hour decorating period as well as during the 8 hour reception rental period from 3:00pm till 11:00pm.

SPECIAL EVENTS
